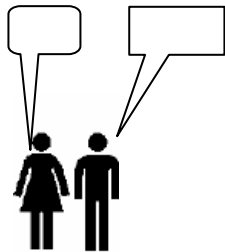


Partner's Projects (PK-2)

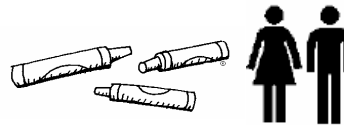
Procedure:

1. Assign a task to be completed or a topic to be discussed (i.e. have a discussion about some places they would like to go).
2. Make a "Happy Talk" chart or review the chart from previous lessons.
3. Partners discuss topic or do task.
4. Partners draw a picture of something they talked about or complete the product from doing the task. Each person signs his/her name on the picture or product.
5. Evaluate how well the partners used Happy Talk while they worked together. If they remember hearing their partner use happy talk, they draw a happy face by their partner's name on the picture or product. Call on a few students so they can share the happy talk they heard their partners use.
6. The whole class meets together in Community Circle to share. Remind the students to use active listening by having their pictures on the floor so their hands can be quiet.
7. One person holds the picture or product and the other person tell about the picture or product.
8. Evaluate use of active listening during the sharing by having the students show the correct number of fingers to indicate how well they feel the class did.
9. Debrief the lesson to find out how well it worked for the students to share the responsibility to the drawing of the picture.

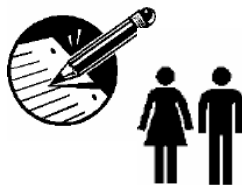
- 1. Talk –**
